



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

State Transformation Commission (STC)

Government of Uttar Pradesh

And

Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University,

Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day of ^{7th} 05th August, 2026, between:

State Transformation Commission (STC), Government of Uttar Pradesh, having its office at Yojna Bhawan, Sarojini Naidu Marg, Lucknow, hereinafter referred to as the **"First Party"**;

AND

Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University, Gorakhpur, established under the Government of Uttar Pradesh, having its office at Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh, hereinafter referred to as the **"Second Party"**.

The First Party and the Second Party are hereinafter collectively referred to as the **"Parties"**.

Preamble

Whereas, the State Transformation Commission (STC), Government of Uttar Pradesh, is committed to strengthening public health systems through evidence-based policies, innovation, and inter-sectoral collaboration for improving health outcomes across the State.

Whereas, Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University is a premier institution dedicated to excellence in AYUSH education, research, healthcare, and community outreach, with expertise in preventive, promotive, curative, and rehabilitative healthcare.

Recognizing the need for collaborative efforts to improve maternal and public health outcomes, both Parties agree to work together for achieving sustainable health transformation in Uttar Pradesh.

Objective

The primary objective of this MoU is to establish a framework for collaboration between the State Transformation Commission, Government of Uttar Pradesh, and Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University for providing strategic, technical, academic, and research support in strengthening the health system.

The University shall work in close collaboration with the Health Cell of the State Transformation Commission to support the implementation of the roadmap for averting preventable maternal mortality with the vision of achieving **Zero Preventable Maternal Mortality**.

Further, under this MoU, the University shall provide strategic and technical support to the State Transformation Commission in strengthening the preventive, promotive, curative, and rehabilitative healthcare components across Uttar Pradesh and contribute to the overall transformation agenda of the Commission.

Scope of Collaboration

The Parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:

Preparation of Guidelines and SOPs

- Develop evidence-based guidelines, operational manuals, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), and policy documents for public health and AYUSH interventions.

Program Design and Implementation

- Design implementation frameworks, capacity-building modules, operational methodologies, monitoring tools, digital formats, and efficient rollout of health programs.

Research, Surveys and Studies



- Conduct collaborative research, baseline surveys, implementation research, health impact assessments, and quality-of-life studies.
- Generate evidence for policy formulation and continuous improvement.

Community Awareness and Health Promotion

- Increase awareness regarding AYUSH systems of medicine and healthy lifestyle practices among communities.
- Organize awareness campaigns, health education programs, training workshops, seminars, conferences, and outreach activities.

Evidence-Based Monitoring and Evaluation

- Provide scientific monitoring, evaluation, documentation, community-based household surveys, and evidence-based technical support to STC.
- Develop indicators, dashboards, and reporting mechanisms for monitoring program performance.

Maternal and Child Health

- Support interventions aimed at reducing maternal mortality, anemia, malnutrition, neonatal complications, and improving maternal and child health indicators.

Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases

- Develop preventive and promotive strategies for communicable diseases, non-communicable diseases (NCDs), lifestyle disorders, and public health emergencies.

Capacity Building

- Organize training programs for healthcare professionals, AYUSH practitioners, field workers, and government officials.

Technical Advisory Support

- Provide expert consultation for policy formulation, implementation, monitoring, evaluation, and research activities related to health transformation.

Any Other Mutually Agreed Activity

- Undertake any additional activities jointly agreed upon by both Parties for achieving the objectives of this MoU.

Roles and Responsibilities

State Transformation Commission will:

- Identify priority health areas.
- Provide policy guidance and necessary administrative support.
- Facilitate coordination with relevant government departments.
- Support implementation and monitoring of collaborative activities.

Mahayogi Guru Gorakhnath AYUSH University will:

- Provide technical expertise and academic support.
- Mobilize faculty members, researchers, and students for collaborative activities.
- Conduct research, documentation, monitoring, and evaluation.
- Develop evidence-based recommendations and implementation tools.
- Support awareness generation and capacity-building initiatives.

Financial Arrangement

This Memorandum of Understanding is non-financial in nature. Each Party shall bear its own expenditure incurred during the implementation of activities unless otherwise agreed through separate written agreements for specific projects.

Confidentiality

Both Parties shall maintain confidentiality of all confidential information shared during the course of this collaboration and shall not disclose such information without prior written consent of the other Party, except where required by law.

Duration

This MoU shall remain valid for a period of **three years** from the date of signing and may be extended by mutual written consent of both Parties.

Amendment

Any amendment or modification to this MoU shall be made only through mutual written agreement signed by both Parties.

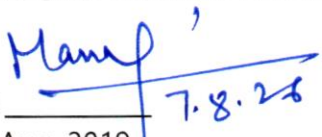
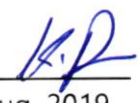


Termination
